This letter is to acknowledge receipt of the *Certification of Compliance with Energy Efficiency Standards for Electric Motors* from Shanghai Top Motor Co., LTD (Shanghai Top), dated July 27, 2009. The Certification of Compliance reports on and certifies that certain basic models of electric motors manufactured or distributed by Shanghai Top comply with the applicable energy efficiency requirements contained in Title 10 of the Code of Federal Regulations, Part 431 (10 CFR Part 431), *Energy Conservation Program for Certain Commercial and Industrial Equipment* and Part C of the *Energy Policy and Conservation Act*, 42 U.S.C. 6311 *et seq.*


